The fund supports journalism that reaches beyond routine reporting to uncover facets of life in North Carolina's Triad cities that would otherwise go unexamined. Time-consuming, labor-intensive projects based primary documents, data analysis and extensive interviewing that would ordinarily be considered prohibitively expensive are what we're looking for.

This grant has a rolling deadline.

Successful applicants will be paid upon completion of publishable work.
