

Alvin Robinson Candidate Questionnaire

For all candidates:

- What is your background in politics? If you are an incumbent, please state which offices you have held and when.

I have never served in an elected capacity. However I ran for Guilford County Board of Commissioners and NC State Senate in 2022.

- Why were you drawn to run for office?

I see a need to not only talk about the decline in American society but as a American holding to traditional American values under God, Life, Liberty, the Pursuit of Happiness, I have a responsibility to take actions that work to uphold those values.

For state races:
